

Out-of-State Telemedicine License Eligibility Checklist

You must have a checkmark in each section to be eligible.

Age

License
<input type="checkbox"/> Are you licensed to practice medicine in another state?
Certification
<input type="checkbox"/> Are you ABMS, BOS, or ABOMS specialty board certified?
<input type="checkbox"/> Have you passed a monitored certification, recertification, or maintenance of certification exam for an ABMS, BOS, or ABOMS specialty board within the 10 years preceding your application for licensure ?

If you have any of the following you are NOT eligible:

Character
<input type="checkbox"/> disciplinary action by another state or jurisdiction
<input type="checkbox"/> a medical license, permit, or other authority to practice medicine that is currently restricted for cause, canceled for cause, suspended for cause, revoked or subject to another form of discipline in a state or territory of the United States, Canada, or a uniformed service of United States.
<input type="checkbox"/> an investigation or proceeding pending for the restriction, cancellation, suspension, revocation, or other discipline of the medical license, permit or authority to practice medicine in a state or territory of the United States, a province of Canada, or a uniformed service of the United States
<input type="checkbox"/> a prosecution pending in any state, federal or Canadian court for any offense that under the laws of this state is a felony, a misdemeanor that involves the practice of medicine, or a misdemeanor that involves a crime of moral turpitude.

The Board may refuse to issue a license to an applicant under the Medical Practice Act, §164.051 (relating to Grounds for Denial or Disciplinary Action).
