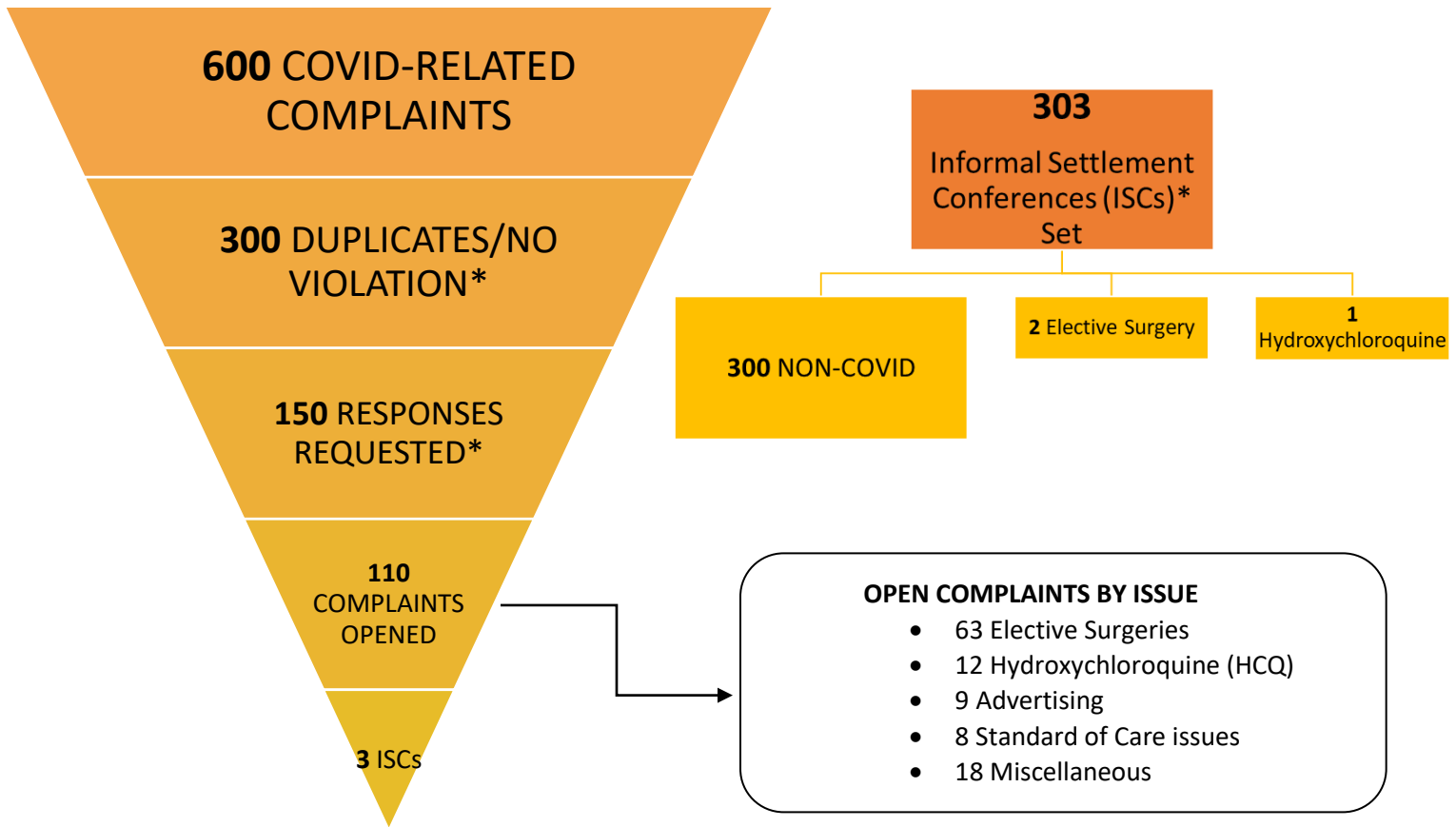

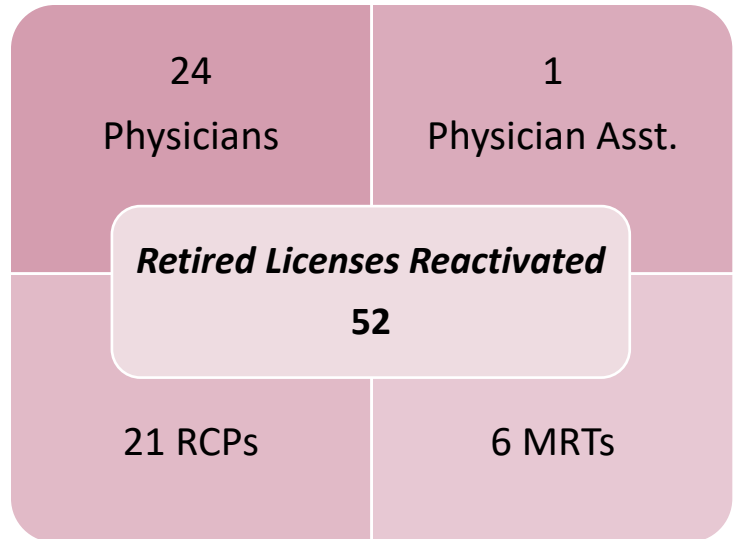
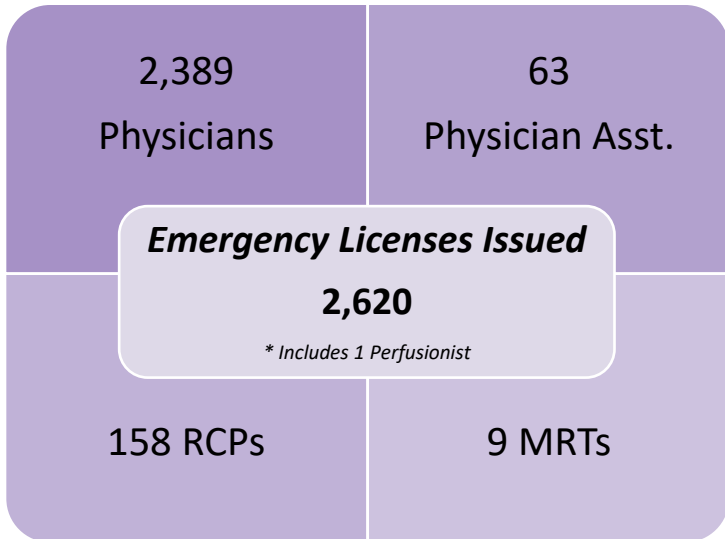

Additional TMB Efforts to Aid in COVID Response

Physician in Training (PIT): Texas hospitals and facilities associated with Graduate Medical Education (GME) training programs allow PIT permit holders to work in areas outside of their GME training program

Physician Assistants (PA), Medical Physicists, Perfusionists, and Respiratory Care: Issued emergency licenses to begin working prior to taking their final licensure exam

Physicians, PAs and APRNs: Allowed oral prescriptive delegation agreements

Chronic Pain Patients: Allowed telephone refill(s) of prescriptions for existing chronic pain patients

Expansion of Telemedicine: Allowed providers to establish a physician-patient relationship via telephone and enables phone consults to diagnose, treat, order tests, and prescribe for all conditions
