Applicant #481s application was reviewed due to a mental condition that may affect the practice of medicine.

Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to 3 names for treating psychiatrist for approval by the Executive Director.
 Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board four times each year.
- See the treating psychiatrist once a month for no less than 6 months, then as dictated by the treating psychiatrist.
- Submit reports regarding mental condition on request.
- o Shall not withdraw from care or treatment.
- o Will notify Compliance Dept upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- o Practice restricted to a group or institutional setting.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- o Probation appearance at least once during the first year and then on request.
