Applicant #572s application was reviewed due to a mental condition that may affect the practice of medicine.

Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training Permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the Physician in Training Permit that includes the following requirements:

- Continue treatment with current treating psychiatrist. Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Frequency of visits to be dictated by the treating psychiatrist.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment
- o Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearances anytime on request and 10 days notice.
