EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE Meeting Minutes August 27, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by the Chair, Michael Arambula, M.D., PharmD. Committee members present were Paulette Southard; Timothy Webb, J.D.; and George Willeford III, M.D. Margaret McNeese, M.D., was not present. Agenda item #4, Update on Sunset Self-Evaluation Report. Ms. Robinson provided a summary of the Sunset Review process for the 2016-2017 review cycle. Ms. Robinson and Ms. Goode presented a draft of the agency's Sunset self-evaluation report that will be submitted to the Sunset Advisory Commission on 9/1/15.

Agenda item #3, Discussion, recommendation, and possible action on the FY15 Internal Audit. Kimberly Lopez-Gonzales, CPA, presented the FY15 Annual Internal Audit Report, which focused on physician licensing. Ms. Southard moved, Mr. Webb seconded, and the motion passed to approve the 2015 Annual Internal Audit Report.
