

**Action Item Agenda Item 2a1 Applicant #803
Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public/Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order**

Applicant #803 appeared before the Committee, in executive session, on referral by the Executive Director. In open session, **Mr. Ellis moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the requirements specified in the Rehabilitation Checklist that has been distributed to the members of the committee.** This recommendation is due to applicants intemperate use of alcohol that could endanger a patients life. Factors contributing to this recommendation include evidence of a drinking problem in residency training; arrest for public intoxication; recent diagnosis of alcohol abuse; and mitigating factors include the applicants current AA attendance, psychological counseling, and sobriety. **Ms. Southard seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**
