Applicant #803 appeared before the Committee, in executive session, on referral by the Executive Director. In open session, Mr. Ellis moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the requirements specified in the Rehabilitation Checklist that has been distributed to the members of the committee. This recommendation is due to applicants intemperate use of alcohol that could endanger a patients life. Factors contributing to this recommendation include evidence of a drinking problem in residency training; arrest for public intoxication; recent diagnosis of alcohol abuse; and mitigating factors include the applicants current AA attendance, psychological counseling, and sobriety. Ms. Southard seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.
