Temporary Suspension (without Notice)**

On March 11, 2009, a Disciplinary Panel of the Board entered an Order of Temporary Suspension (Without Notice of Hearing) against the medical license of Dr. Randy Ramahi after concluding that Dr. Ramahi's continuation in the practice of medicine presents a continuing threat to the public welfare. The length of the temporary suspension remains in effect pending further Board action. This immediate temporary suspension without notice was initiated after the Board found evidence that Dr. Ramahi, who has a history of: prescribing controlled substances to himself and/or family members; being under psychiatric care for addiction-related issues; and having been disciplined by the Board, had prescribed narcotics for himself and/or family members in September 2008. In January 2009, Dr. Ramahi again prescribed controlled substances for a family member, and did so without a valid DEA or DPS certifications for prescribing such drugs.
