TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD LICENSURE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES June 9, 2016

The meeting was called to order 11:16 a.m. by Chair, Timothy Webb. Committee members present were Michael Arambula, M.D., Pharm.D., Frank S. Denton; Carlos Gallardo, John R Guerra, D.O., and Robert B. Simonson, D.O.

Agenda Item 2 - Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding the substantial equivalence of Ross University School of Medicine. Ms Johnston summarized the history of the Advanced Introduction Clinical Medicine (AICM) course, which is now known Internal Medicine Foundations (IMF). The content of each course was discussed as well as the rationale for the name change and the decline in the number of weeks in the most current course. Ms. Johnston also explained that in December 2015 the committee directed staff to research the courses further and bring the information back to the committee in June 2016 for their review. Ms. Laura Martin, Attorney and Ms. Paula Wells, EdD, Sr. Associate Dean of Academic and Student Affairs at Ross University attempted to explain why the name and content of the course has changed over the years. The Committee directed to staff to implement the following for Ross Univ School of Medicine graduates:

- Advanced Introduction to Clinical Medicine (AICM) that was completed in Dominica.
 Staff is allowed to calculate the number of course weeks into the total number of required medical education weeks.
- Advanced Introduction to Clinical Medicine (AICM) that was completed in the United States. This is not an approved clinical clerkship or rotation and is not acceptable for licensing requirements in Texas.
- Internal Medicine Foundations (IMF) completed in the United States is not a clerkship or rotation in Internal Medicine and cannot be used towards the total number of required medical education weeks or as an approved clerkship and is not acceptable for licensing requirements in Texas.

Dr. Arambula moved, Mr. Gallardo seconded, that the Committee close the meeting to the public and continue in Executive Session for deliberations concerning Agenda Item 3. The motion passed. Mr. Webb announced that the meeting would be closed for deliberations at 12:22 p.m. concerning licensure applications and the character and fitness of applicants under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009 and 155.058, Occupations Code, and that while in executive session, the Board would not take any action, make any decision, or vote with regard to any matter that may be considered or discussed. A certified agenda of any executive session will be made.

The Executive Session ended at 5:13 p.m. The Licensure Committee conducted hearings to review applicants and licensees appearing concerning eligibility. The hearings were conducted in Executive Session. Following the hearings, the Committee reconvened and considered the applications.

Agenda Item 3 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Licensee Requests.

Applicant #1799 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session Mr. Denton moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant's appeal is denied and the original determination of ineligibility stands. This recommendation is due to the applicant's failure to meet statutory requirements for licensure. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1812 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session **Dr. Simonson moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant's appeal be granted and that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. Dr. Arambula seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1801 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session Mr. Gallardo moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant's appeal is denied and the original determination of ineligibility stands. This

recommendation is due to the applicant's failure to meet statutory requirements for licensure. **Mr. Denton seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1788 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session **Mr**. Gallardo moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a license subject to certain terms and conditions under an Agreed Order with the following conditions:

• Applicant must practice in the specialty of Occupational Medicine and

• Applicant must practice in a group setting or institutional setting This recommendation is due to disciplinary action taken by a health care entity. Dr. Simonson seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1798 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Gallardo moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for a license.** This recommendation is based on disciplinary action taken by a health care entity and unprofessional conduct. **Dr. Simonson seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1809 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Dr. Guerra moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license**. **Dr. Arambula seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1794 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Mr. Denton moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for a license. This recommendation is due to repeated or recurring meritorious health care liability claims and disciplinary action by another state. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1789 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Mr. Gallardo moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the

applicant be granted an unrestricted license. Dr Simonson seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1804 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Dr**. **Arambula moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted Temporary General Medical Radiologic Technologist certificate. Mr. Denton seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1795 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Dr**. Guerra moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be listed in the Non-Certified Radiologic Technologist Registry. Dr. Arambula seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1813 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Dr**. Guerra moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a license subject to certain terms and conditions under an Agreed Order with the following conditions:

- Must submit to drug testing, as ordered by the board
- Must complete a board approved independent medical examination within 3 months of being directed to complete the exam
- If examination and drug testing identify no issues, the order auto terminates, if issues are identified, then applicant must return to a subsequent Informal Settlement Conference Panel for consideration of further action

This recommendation is due to the applicant's criminal history. Mr. Denton seconded the motion. Mr. Gallardo voted against the notion. All others voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1808 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, Mr. Gallardo moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be

determined ineligible for a license due to the applicant's criminal history. Dr. Arambula seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 3b - Proposed orders offered by the Executive Director.

Ms. Johnston reported on 9 physician licensure, 1 temporary general medical radiological technologist, 4 respiratory care practitioner and 2 general medical radiological technologist remedial plans and agreed orders offered by the Executive Director and accepted by applicants. Mr. Gallardo moved to recommend to the full Board that the remedial plans and orders be approved. Mr. Denton seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 3c – Physician licensure applicants to be licensed.

There were **115** applicants who met all requirements to be considered for permanent licensure by the full Board. **Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full Board that all 115 physician** licensure applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 3d – Surgical assistant licensure applicants to be licensed.

There were 13 surgical assistant applicants who met all requirements to be considered for licensure by the full Board. Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full Board that all 13 surgical assistant applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Dr. Guerra seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 3e – Acudetox Specialist applicants to be certified.

There were 2 Acudetox Specialist applicants who met all requirements to be considered for certification by the full Board. Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full Board that the 2 Acudetox applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 4 – Report on licensure statistics.

Ms. Johnston reported that for FY15, Quarter 3, 1256 new physician licenses were issued in an average processing time of 35 days. Ms. Johnston also reported that for FY16, Quarter 3, 1124 new physician licenses were issued in an average of 35 days.

Agenda Item 5a - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding cancellation of licenses by request for incomplete registration – Surgical Assistants – There were none

Agenda Item 5b - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding cancellation of licenses by request for incomplete registration – Acudetox Specialists. There were 11 Acudetox Specialist certifications for cancellation. Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full Board that all 11 Acudetox Specialist certifications to be cancelled. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 6a Nonprofit Health Organizations - Applications for Initial Certification. There were 11 applications for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full Board that the 11 requests for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Dr. Simonson seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 6b Nonprofit Health Organizations - Applications for Biennial Recertification There were 24 applications for biennial recertification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. Dr. Simonson moved to recommend to the full Board that the 24 requests for biennial recertification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Agenda Item 6c Nonprofit Health Organizations – Cancellation of Certifications – There were none

Agenda Item 7 Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding proposed amendments to board rules. This item was pulled from the agenda.

Agenda Item 8 Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding Surgical

Assistant Licenses. Mr. Denton presented options for possible rules changes related to the accreditation of surgical assistant programs. Mr. Denton stated that he is requesting a change because under the current rules an applicant would be ineligible for licensure should their program lose accreditation anytime while the applicant is enrolled. Mr. Denton explained that it seemed unfair for an applicant who invests that amount of time in their education to ultimately be ineligible for licensure. Mr. Denton further stated that since a license is not even required for surgical assistants to practice in Texas, being so strict on the accreditation status of the program did not seem sensible. After discussion the Committee felt that the current rule should remained unchanged at this time.

Agenda Item 9 - There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:57 p.m.
