Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
November 29, 2007

Applicant #581's application was reviewed due to a mental impairment.

Dr. Benavides moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for ten years that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to three names for treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director; see at least once every month. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
