Licensure Committee Proposed **Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order  
December 7, 2006

Applicant #234s application was reviewed due to drug abuse and Major Depression.

Ms. Fredricks moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- Submit to alcohol and drug screens by any approved physician.
- AA meetings three times each week.
- Participate in medical society health and rehabilitation program one time a week.
- Submit three names for treating psychiatrist for approval of ED; see no less than once a month then as recommended.
- Submit three names for monitoring forensic psychiatrist for approval of ED with quarterly reports.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- Shall not treat self or immediate family.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once 1<sup>st</sup> year and then on request.
