This recommendation is due to applicants mental condition that could potentially render applicant unable to safely practice medicine. Factors contributing to this recommendation include that applicant was diagnosed with Major Depressive Disorder that affected applicants academic performance and required nearly a year-long leave of absence. Dr. Benavides seconded the motion.
