

TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD
LICENSURE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
August 15, 2019

The meeting was called to order 10:20 a.m. by Chair, Timothy Webb, J.D. Other Committee members present were Michael Cokinos, George De Loach, D.O., Frank S. Denton, Kandace Farmer, D.O., Jeffrey L. Luna, M.D., Jayaram B. Naidu, M.D. and Karl Swann, M.D..

Committee member absent were Roberto Martinez, M.D. and Linda Molina, J.D.

Charles W. Beasley, Ph.D., with the Medical Physicist Board also attended the meeting.

Agenda Item 4 – Applicants for Licensure, Permit or Certification

Agenda Item 4b – Proposed orders offered by the Executive Director.

Ms. Johnston reported on **1 Agreed Order and 1 Remedial Plan** offered by the Executive Director and accepted by the applicants. After discussion **Dr. Farmer moved to recommend to the full Board that the 1 Agreed Order and 1 Remedial Plan be approved. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4c – Physician licensure applicants to be licensed.

Ms. Johnston reported that there were **255** applicants who met all requirements to be considered for permanent licensure by the full Board. **Mr. Cokinos moved to recommend to the full Board that all 255 physician licensure applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4d – Surgical assistant licensure applicants to be licensed.

Ms. Johnston reported that were **14** surgical assistant applicants who met all requirements to be considered for licensure by the full Board. **Mr. Denton moved to recommend to the full Board that all 14 surgical assistant applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Dr. Naidu seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4e – Acudetox Specialist applicants to be certified.

Ms. Johnston reported that was **3** Acudetox specialist applicant who met all requirements to be considered for certification by the full Board. **Dr. Naidu moved to recommend to the full Board that the 3 Acudetox specialist applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 5 – Report on licensure statistics.

Ms. Johnston reported that in Quarter 4 of FY18, 1260 new physician licenses were issued in an average processing time of 41 days. In Quarter 4 of FY19, as of August 15, 2019, 1199 licenses were issued in an average processing time of 31 days. A total of 4725 licenses have been issued in FY19, as of August 15, 2019, in an average processing time of 34 days.

Agenda Item 6a – Cancellation of Licenses by request or for incomplete registration – Surgical Assistants. Ms. Johnston reported that were **16** Surgical Assistant licenses for cancellation by request or for incomplete registration. **Mr. Cokinos moved to recommend to the full Board that all 13 Surgical Assistant licenses be cancelled. Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 6b – Cancellation of Licenses by request or for incomplete registration – Acudetox. There are none.

Agenda Item 7a -Nonprofit Health Organizations - Applicants for Initial Certification.

Ms. Johnston reported that were **4** applicants for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Dr. Farmer moved to recommend to the full Board that the 4 requests for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 7b - Nonprofit Health Organizations - Requests for Biennial Recertification.

Ms. Johnston reported that were **56** requests for biennial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Mr. Cokinos moved to recommend to the full Board that the 56 requests for biennial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Dr. De Loach seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 7c - Nonprofit Health Organizations – Cancellation of organizations certified as Nonprofit Health Organizations. Ms. Johnston reported that were **13** applications for

cancellation of certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Dr. Luna moved to recommend to the full Board that the 13 cancellations of certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Dr. De Loach seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 8 – Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding **proposed amendments to Title 22 of the Texas Administrative Code.**

- a. Chapter 160. Medical Physicists**
 - §160.31 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses – Medical Physicists
- b. Chapter 163. Licensure**
 - §163.3 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses - Physicians
- c. Chapter 183. Acupuncture**
 - §183.27 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses - Acupuncture
- d. Chapter 185. Physician Assistants**
 - §185.33 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses – Physician Assistants
- e. Chapter 186. Respiratory Care Practitioners**
 - §186.30 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses Respiratory Care Practitioners
- f. Chapter 188 Perfusionists**
 - §188.30 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses Perfusionists
- g. Chapter 194. Medical Radiologic Technologists**
 - §194.34 – Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses Medical Radiologic Technicians

Mr. Freshour explained that the proposed amendment is the same for each chapter and delineates the process for certain military spouses to obtain an exemption from licensure as outlined in SB1200. He further explained that the bill allows a military spouse to practice for not more than three years if the spouse is currently licensed by another jurisdiction with equivalent license requirements. **After discussion, Dr. Swann moved to recommend to the full Board that the rules as presented be published in the Texas Register for public comment. Dr. Farmer seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Agenda Item 2 – Licensee requests. There are none.

Agenda Item 3 – Accreditation of Medical Physicist Programs.

The committee reviewed the information provided by an applicant. Charles W. Beasley, Ph.D., of the Medical Physicist Advisory Committee provided insight on his review of the documentation as well, stating that someone who did not complete an educational or residency program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Medical Physics Education Programs (CAMPEP) would not be able to sit for the American Board of Radiology certification exams. After discussion it was determined that the degree issued by John Patrick University of Health and Applied Sciences (formerly Radiological Technologies University VT) does not meet the education requirements for a temporary or full Medical Physicist license as outlined under Board rules.

Agenda Item 4 Continued – Applicants for Licensure, Permit or Certification

Mr. Cokinos moved and Dr. Farmer seconded that the Committee close the meeting to the public and continue in Executive Session for deliberations concerning Agenda Item 4a. The motion passed. Mr. Webb announced that the meeting would be closed for deliberations at 11:03 a.m. concerning licensure applications and the character and fitness of applicants under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009 and 155.058, Occupations Code, and that while in executive session, the Board would not take any action, make any decision, or vote with regard to any matter that may be considered or discussed. A certified agenda of any executive session will be made.

The Executive Session ended at 5:01 p.m. The Licensure Committee conducted hearings to review licensees appearing concerning eligibility. The hearings were conducted in Executive Session. Following the hearings, the Committee reconvened and considered the applications.

Dr. Beasley left the meeting at 11:13 a.m.

Mr. Carlton entered the meeting at 2:30 p.m.

Agenda Item 4a - Applicants appearing concerning eligibility.

Applicant #1303 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Dr. De Loach** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's appeal be denied. Further, that upon receipt within one calendar year of a request for a physician-in-training permit for an ACMGE or AOA accredited training program in ophthalmology of at least one year in length that the Executive Director may grant a physician training permit. **Mr. Cokinos** seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Applicant #2177 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Denton** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's application for reinstatement of their license be deferred for 8 months from August 16, 2019 in order to comply with all KSTAR recommendations made in June 2019. If the Applicant does not comply with all KSTAR recommendations in the 8-month period, their application will be automatically denied. **Dr. Luna** seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Applicant #2281 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Dr. Farmer** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be granted reinstatement of their license subject to an Agreed Order. The Agreed Order will have the following conditions:

- The Applicant is restricted to practice in a group or institutional setting approved in advance in the discretion of the Executive Director for a period of one year.
- Upon receipt of favorable reports and after the completion of one year of practice in a group of institutional setting, the order will automatically terminate.
- The license is effective on the date the Applicant is reinstated by staff following the return of the signed Agreed Order.

This recommendation is due to the Applicant's disciplinary history. **Dr. De Loach** seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Applicant #2320 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Denton** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be determined ineligible for a license due to the applicant's inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients due to intemperate use of alcohol and

drugs that could endanger the public. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. Mr. Cokinos, Mr. Denton, Dr. Farmer, Dr. Naidu and Dr. Swann voted in favor. Dr. De Loach voted nay. The motion passed.

Applicant #2321 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Dr. Luna moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be determined ineligible for a license due to the applicant's inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients. Dr. Farmer seconded the motion.

Mr. Denton proposed an alternate motion for consideration. He suggested that a determination be deferred pending completion of an evaluation by KSTAR and upon satisfactory completion of KSTAR and all recommendations made by the program that the applicant reappear before the Committee for a determination.

Dr. Luna indicated that the Applicant could self-refer to KSTAR and comply with all recommendations even if they do not have an active application with the Board.

Dr. Luna requested a vote on his motion. Mr. Cokinos, Dr. De Loach, Dr. Farmer, Dr. Luna, Dr. Naidu and Dr. Swann voted in favor. Mr. Denton voted nay. The motion passed.

Applicant #2322 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Dr. De Loach moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant receive a private referral to the Texas Physician's Health Program (TXPHP) for evaluation and compliance with all requirements and recommendations by the program. This recommendation is due to the applicant's inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients due to mental condition. Upon receipt of resolution with the TXPHP, the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Applicant #2323 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Mr. Cokinos moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's appeal be granted and the Applicant be issued a Physician in Training (PIT) Permit subject to an Agreed Order. The Agreed Order will have the following conditions:

- **The Applicant will receive a public referral to the Texas Physician's Health Program (TXPHP) and must comply with all recommendations.**
- **The Applicant be required to appear before the Licensure Committee should they file any application with the Board in the future.**
- **The permit is effective on the date the PIT Permit is issued by staff following the return of the signed Agreed Order.**

This recommendation is due to the Applicant's inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients due to intemperate use of drugs that could endanger the public. **Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Applicant #2326 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Dr. De Loach** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be granted reinstatement of their license subject to an Agreed Order. The Agreed Order will have the following conditions:

- **The Applicant is restricted to practice in a group or institutional setting approved in advance in the discretion of the Executive Director of the Board for a period of one year.**
- **The Applicant must pass the most current Texas Medical Jurisprudence Examination within one year.**
- **The Application may not supervise midlevels including PA's and APRNs.**
- **Upon successful completion of the Texas Medical Jurisprudence Examination and receipt of favorable reports after the completion of one year of practice in a group or institutional setting, the order will automatically terminate.**
- **The license is effective on the date the Applicant is reinstated by staff following the return of the signed Agreed Order.**

This recommendation is due to the Applicant's disciplinary history. **Dr. Naidu seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Applicant #2327 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Dr. Naidu** moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be granted reinstatement of their license subject to an Agreed Order. The Agreed Order will have the following conditions:

- **The Applicant is restricted to practice in a group or institutional setting approved in advance in the discretion of the Executive Director for a period of one year.**

- **Upon receipt of favorable reports after the completion of one year of practice in a group or institutional setting the order will automatically terminate.**
- **The license is effective on the date the Applicant is reinstated by staff following the return of the signed Agreed Order.**

This recommendation is due to the Applicant's disciplinary history. **Dr. Luna seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Applicant #2329 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Cokinos moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be granted an unrestricted Physician – in –training (PIT) Permit. Dr. Luna seconded the motion. Mr. Cokinos, Dr. De Loach, Dr. Luna, Dr. Naidu, and Dr. Swann voted in favor. Dr. Farmer and Mr. Denton voted nay. The motion passed.**

Applicant #2330 did not appear before the Committee. In open session, **Mr. Cokinos moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's appeal of the determination of ineligibility be denied.** This recommendation is based on the applicant's failure to provide the required documentation to demonstrate compliance with the courses needed for licensure as required under Board Rule 160.7. **Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4c – The Committee confirmed the modification to the number of physician applicants to be licensed from 256 to 255.

Agenda Item 9 – Adjourn.

There being no further business, **Mr. Cokinos moved to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 5:21 p.m.**

Chapter 160. Medical Physicists.

New Rule 160.31. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director of the Texas Medical Board may authorize a qualified military spouse to practice medical physics in Texas without obtaining a license in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the advisory committee, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing requirements that are determined by the advisory committee to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for certification in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the advisory committee of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the advisory committee; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice medical physics in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice of medical physics in Texas.

(d) Once the advisory committee receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the advisory committee will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing.

Additionally, the advisory committee will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.

Chapter 163. Licensure.

New Rule 163.3. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director may authorize a qualified military spouse to engage in the practice of medicine in Texas without obtaining a license in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the board, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active medical license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing requirements that are determined by the board to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the board of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the board; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice medicine in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice of medicine in Texas.

(d) Once the board receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the board will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing. Additionally, the board will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.

Chapter 183. Acupuncture.

New Rule 183.27. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director of the Texas Medical Board may authorize a qualified military spouse to engage in the practice of acupuncture in Texas without obtaining a license in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the board, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active acupuncture license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing requirements that are determined by the board to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the board of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the board; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice acupuncture in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice of acupuncture in Texas.

(d) Once the board receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the board will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing. Additionally, the board will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.

Chapter 185. Physician Assistants.

New Rule 185.33. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director of the Texas Medical Board may authorize a qualified military spouse to practice as a Physician Assistant in Texas without obtaining a license in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the board, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active physician assistant license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing requirements that are determined by the board to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the board of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the board; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice as a physician assistant in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice as a physician assistant in Texas.

(d) Once the board receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the board will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing. Additionally, the board will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.

Chapter 186. Respiratory Care Practitioners.

New Rule 186.30. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director of the Texas Medical Board may authorize a qualified military spouse to practice as a respiratory care practitioner in Texas without obtaining a certificate in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the advisory board, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active respiratory care practitioner license or certificate in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing or certification requirements that are determined by the advisory board to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for certification in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the advisory board of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the advisory board; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice respiratory care in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice of respiratory care in Texas.

(d) Once the advisory board receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the advisory board will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing. Additionally, the advisory board will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.

Chapter 188. Perfusionists.

New Rule 188.30. Exemption from Licensure for Certain Military Spouses.

(a) The executive director of the Texas Medical Board may authorize a qualified military spouse to practice perfusion in Texas without obtaining a license in accordance with §55.0041(a), Texas Occupations Code. This authorization to practice is valid during the time the military service member to whom the military spouse is married is stationed at a military installation in Texas, but not to exceed three years.

(b) In order to receive authorization to practice from the advisory committee, the military spouse must:

(A) hold an active license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country that:

(1) has licensing requirements that are determined by the advisory committee to be substantially equivalent to the requirements for certification in Texas;

(2) is not subject to any restriction, disciplinary order, probation, or investigation;

(B) notify the advisory committee of the military spouse's intent to practice in Texas on a form prescribed by the advisory committee; and

(C) submit proof of the military spouse's residency in this state, a copy of the spouse's military identification card, and proof of the military member's status as an active duty military service member as defined by § 437.001(1), Texas Government Code (relating to Definitions).

(c) While authorized to practice perfusion in Texas, the military spouse shall comply with all other laws and regulations applicable to the practice of perfusion in Texas.

(d) Once the advisory committee receives the form containing notice of a military spouse's intent to practice in Texas, the advisory committee will verify whether the military spouse's license in another state, territory, Canadian province, or country is active and in good standing.

Additionally, the advisory committee will determine whether the licensing requirements in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Texas.
