Applicant #567s application was reviewed due to a history of alcohol abuse.

Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for ten years that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program.
- o Independent Psychiatric Evaluation by a psychiatrist appointed by the ED and follow recommendations. If continued care recommended, applicant submit up to 3 names as treating psychiatrist for approval of ED. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist 4 times each year.
- Monitoring psychiatrist for treatment. Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or ED appoints a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to furnish reports to Board 2 times each year.
- Standard requirements: Reports by applicant regarding physician or mental condition on request, no unilateral withdrawal from care or treatment and notify compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- o May supervise PAs and APNs.
- o Probation appearance one time the first year and then on request.
