Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
October 5, 2006

Applicant #501s application was reviewed due to mental impairment.

Dr. Pascua-Lim moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a full medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for five years under the following requirements:

- Submit to an independent psychiatric evaluation by a board certified forensic psychiatrist selected by the boards Executive Director. This forensic psychiatrist will also serve as a monitor for the applicants continuing treatment.
- Continue treatment with current treating psychiatrist as recommended by the treating psychiatrist.
- Reports regarding physical and mental condition are to be submitted quarterly by the treating psychiatrist and every 6 months by the monitoring forensic psychiatrist.
- Shall not withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the 1st year and then on request.
