If continued care recommended, Respondent submit up to 3 names as treating psychiatrist for approval of ED. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist 4 times each year. [NO UNILATERAL WITHDRAWAL] Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment [e12]

12. **[PROGRAM DIRECTOR TO REPORT ON PIT HOLDER]** Respondent must give copy of Order to Program Director and request quarterly reports [e____]

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

23. **[ABILITY TO SUPERVISE]** May May NOT supervise PAs [o02]

NOTE: If Order includes restrictions on license; PA Act prohibits supervision.

PROBATION APPEARANCES

27. **[ON REQUEST & NOTICE]** Anytime on request & 10 days notice [l02]

- change of address notification
- Violation constitutes unprofessional conduct
- modification or termination request after one year
