Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
November 29, 2007

Applicant #605s application was reviewed due to a mental impairment and falsification of application.

Dr. Oswalt moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be allowed to withdraw the application for a Physician-In-Training Permit, due to providing false or misleading information to the Board. Further, Dr. Oswalt moved to recommend to the full Board that upon submission of an application with truthful answers, the applicant be granted a Physician-In-Training Permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the PIT Permit that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to three names for treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director; see at least once every three months. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- Applicant must give copy of Order to Program Director and request quarterly reports.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
