Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
December 7, 2006

Applicant #530s application was reviewed due to appeal a determination of ineligibility.

Ms. Attebury moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a private, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- Submit to alcohol and drug screens by any approved physician.
- AA meetings two times each week.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once 1st year and then on request.
