Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
February 7, 2008

Applicant #613s application was reviewed due to a history of arrests, outpatient treatment for controlled substance, and monitoring by his medical school.

Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas physician in training permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of his postgraduate training permit that includes the following requirements:

- Submit to independent psychiatric evaluation by a psychiatrist appointed by the Executive Director and follow recommendations. If continued care recommended, respondent submits up to three names as treating psychiatrist for approval by the Executive Director. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Participation in AA or any equivalent program will be at the discretion of the independent forensic psychiatrist conducting the required medical evaluation.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
