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### **TMB suspends Sugar Land physician**

On April 2, 2015, a disciplinary panel of the Texas Medical Board temporarily suspended, with notice, the Texas medical license of Abraham K. Peringol, M.D., after determining his continuation in the practice of medicine poses a continuing threat to public welfare. The suspension was effective immediately.

The Board panel found that Dr. Peringol was terminated from his employment after an investigation into inappropriate conduct involving multiple patients.

Dr. Peringol's conduct constitutes a pattern of practice including professional boundary violations wherein he hugs, kisses, and/or engages in sexual contact and inappropriate discussions with female patients. This pattern of conduct is unprofessional and disruptive in nature, and interferes with, or could reasonably be expected to adversely impact, the quality of care rendered to a patient.

The temporary suspension remains in place until the Board takes further action.

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
