## TEXAS STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT EXAMINERS DISCIPLINARY AND ETHICS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES May 2, 2003

Agenda item #2, the reporting of the February and March 2003 Enforcement Reports, were considered. This was an informational item only and no action was necessary. Board members were reminded of the confidentiality of all information in the Enforcement Report by Ms. Shackelford.

Agenda item #3, regarding review of probationers appearances, was considered. Open session resumed at 10:52 a.m. and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made. Following discussion, Mr. Webb moved, Ms. Bentley seconded and the motion passed, to waive probation appearances for the probationers determined to be in full compliance and identified on the list attached to the Board minutes.

Mr. Webb moved, Dr. Benold seconded, and the motion passed to go into executive session at 10:54 a.m. for private consultation and advice of counsel concerning pending or contemplated litigation, deliberations concerning licensure applications, and/or possible disciplinary action under the authority of the Open Meetings Act.
