MINUTES OF THE
DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE

August 18, 2022 9:30 am

Chair, Manuel Quinones, Jr., M.D., called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Other members present were Sharon Barnes, Devinder S. Bhatia, M.D., James S. Distefano, D.O., LuAnn Morgan, Jason K. Tibbles, M.D., David G. Vanderweide, M.D. and Sherif Zaafran, M.D. Robert Gracia was not in attendance.

Staff members present were Stephen Brint Carlton, J.D., Executive Director; Robert Bredt, M.D., Medical Director; Chris Palazola, J.D., Director of Operations; and various other staff.

Agenda Item #2. Texas Physician Health Program (TXPHP).

A. Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Case Referrals

Dr. Bhatia moved and Dr. Distefano seconded that TXPHP Case No. 22-1102 be returned to the jurisdiction of the TMB. Motion carried.

Dr. Bhatia moved and Ms. Morgan seconded that TXPHP Case No. 11-0239-B, 16-0167-A, 16-0262-A, 17-0376-A, 17-0452, 19-1110-A, 20-0104, 21-0205, 21-1102, 21-1203 and 22-0211 remain under the management of TXPHP, with direction to staff to work on a process that will enable PHP to conduct welfare checks for participants while maintaining confidentiality of the participant's enrollment in the program . Motion carried.

Ms. Morgan moved and Ms. Barnes seconded to grant the waiver requests for Case 15-020. The motion carried.

Agenda Item #6. Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Rule Review and Proposed Changes to the Following Chapters in Title 22 of the Texas Administrative Code

There are none.

Agenda Item #7. Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding follow-up files previously referred from DPRC.

Dr. Tibbels moved and Dr. Vanderweide seconded that follow-up file #21-1091 be dismissed. The motion carried.

Agenda Item #8. Cases Recommended for Dismissal.

A. Non-Standard of Care Cases

Ms. Barnes moved and Ms. Morgan seconded that files under Non-Standard of Care assigned to Ms. Barnes be dismissed as recommended with the exception of file #22-0552, with direction to staff to dismiss and refer #22-0552 to the Pharmacy Board, and #22-4123, which should be dismissed with a custom letter. The motion carried.

Ms. Morgan moved and Dr. Distefano seconded that files under Non-Standard of Care assigned to Ms. Morgan be dismissed as recommended with the exception of 22-0434, which should be dismissed with a custom letter regarding boundaries. The motion carried.

B. Standard of Care Cases

Dr. Quinones moved and Ms. Barnes seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Quinones be dismissed as recommended with the exception of 22-0106, which should be sent back to an ISC panel. The motion carried.

Dr. Bhatia moved and Dr. Tibbels seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Bhatia be dismissed as recommended with the exception of 22-1431, which should be sent back to investigations for a second expert panel review. The motion carried.

Dr. Distefano moved and Dr. Bhatia seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Distefano be dismissed as recommended. The motion carried.

Dr. Tibbels moved and Dr. Distefano seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Tibbels be dismissed as recommended. The motion carried.

Dr. Vanderweide moved and Dr. Bhatia seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Vanderweide be dismissed as recommended with the exception of 21-7915, which should be sent back to investigations and returned to the committee as a follow-up file. Dr. Distefano recused. The motion passed.

At 11:57 am, Dr. Zaafran moved and Ms. Barnes seconded, to go into Executive Session for private consultation and advice of counsel concerning pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers, and/or legal matters subject to the attorney-client privilege under the authority of the Open Meetings Act Section 551.071, Government Code.

Open session resumed at 12:50 pm, and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made.

There was a break from 12:50 – 1:11 p.m.

Dr. Zaafran moved and Ms. Barnes seconded that 22-0399 be offered a remedial plan with 4 hours of CME in the topic of Risk Management, and 4 hours of CME in the topic of Consent, Timeout, and Perioperative Procedures, the hours of which must be completed within one year of the plan's entry by the Board, and an administration fee of \$500 to be paid within 60 days of the plan's entry by the Board. The motion passed.

Dr. Zaafran moved and Dr. Tibbels seconded that case number 22-0467 be sent back to a second ISC. . The motion passed.

Dr. Zaafran moved and Dr. Distefano seconded that all cases under Standard of Care assigned to Dr. Zaafran be dismissed as recommended. The motion passed.

At 1:24 pm, Dr. Quinones moved and Ms. Barnes seconded to go into Executive Session for deliberations concerning disciplinary action, investigative information, peer review information, and rehabilitation orders under the authority of the Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009, 160.006 through 160.008, 164.007(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Open session resumed at 7:37 pm, and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made.
