Applicant #620s application was reviewed due to a mental condition that may affect the practice of medicine.

Mr. Webb moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for five years that includes the following requirements:

- Submit to independent psychiatric evaluation that includes a MMPI, by a psychiatrist appointed by the Executive Director and follow recommendations. If continued care recommended, respondent submits up to three names as treating psychiatrist for approval by the Executive Director. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- O Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- o Restriction to approved group/institutional setting.
- May not supervise PAs and APNs.
- o Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
