TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD MINUTES OF THE DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE August 28, 2014

Chair Margaret C. McNeese, M.D. called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m. Other members present were Julie K. Attebury, David Baucom, Manuel Guajardo, M.D., James "Scott" Holliday, D.O., Allan Shulkin, M.D., Karl W. Swann, M.D., George Willeford III, M.D., Stanley Wang, M.D. and Irvin E.Zeitler, Jr., D.O.

Staff members present were Mari Robinson, Executive Director, Robert Bredt, M.D., Medical Director, and various other staff.

Agenda Item #2. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals and reports from the Texas Physician Health Program (PHP).

The Executive Director, Dr. John B. Fitzwater, presented the status of PHP's current caseload to the DPRC. Dr. Fitzwater discussed the different circumstances of cases the Texas Physician Health Program is currently working and requested additional guidance.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded that PHP Case # 1 remain under the management of PHP. Motion carried.

Mr. Baucom moved, and Dr. Zeitler seconded that PHP Case # 2 remain under the management of PHP with the understanding that if the evaluation comes back showing use of illicit substances, the licensee must cease practice and go to rehab. If the licensee refuses, the case will be referred to the TMB for further action. If the test comes back negative for illicit substances, the case may remain under the management of the PHP under their current agreement with zero tolerance for any future infractions. Motion carried.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that PHP Case # 3 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded that PHP Case # 4 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that PHP Case # 5 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that PHP Case # 6 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #3. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding renewals involving impaired licensees.

It was announced by Ms. Robinson that there weren't any renewal cases to be presented to the DPRC for consideration under Agenda Item 3.

Agenda Item #4. Reports and discussion regarding the Investigation, Litigation and Compliance Departments.

Ms. Robinson presented the Enforcement Report for July 2014, a copy of which is attached. This was an informational item only and no vote was necessary.

Agenda Item #5. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Rule Review and proposed changes to the following chapters in Title 22 of the Texas Administrative Code:

A. Chapter 190, Disciplinary Guidelines, §190.8. Violation Guidelines.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that Agenda Item 5.A. §190.8 be approved for publication. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #6. Review, discussion, and possible action regarding review of probationer's appearances.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that the waiver list on Agenda Item 6 be approved. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #7. Consideration and approval of membership of the Expert Physician Panel.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that the appointments of members to the Expert Physician Panel be accepted as noted in the attachment. Motion carried.

Dr. Zeitler moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded that the removal of the member from the Expert Physician Panel be accepted as noted in the attachment. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #8. Reports and discussion regarding cases over one year old.

Ms. Robinson presented to the DPRC the current status of cases that are over one year old. To date, all investigations over one year are in criminal courts for a resolution and the majority of the litigation cases are at SOAH. This was an informational item only and no vote was necessary.

Agenda Item #10. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding routine followup on investigative files previously referred from the DPRC for follow-up action, specifically including: 13-6223, 13-6504.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that all follow-up files under Agenda Item 10 be dismissed, and that file # 13-6223 be referred to TDI Division of Workers' Comp. Motion carried.

A lunch recess was taken at 11:10 a.m., the committee returned at 1:01 p.m.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded; the motion passed at 1:03 p.m. to go into Executive Session for deliberations concerning disciplinary action, investigative information, peer review information, and rehabilitation orders under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009, 160.006 through .008, 164.007(c), Texas Occupations Code. Open session resumed at 3:01 p.m. and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Shulkin seconded that the appeal of Item 9.A.i, Log # 14-3136 be denied, and to direct staff to refer the complaint to the proper authority for investigating HIPAA violations. Motion carried.

Dr. Shulkin moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded that the appeal of Item 9.B., Log # 14-4636 be denied. Motion carried. Dr. Wang and Dr. Willeford recused themselves from any discussion and decision regarding 14-4636.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Guajardo seconded that all other appeals under Agenda Item 9.A.i. not specifically granted be denied. Motion carried.

Dr. Guajardo moved, and Dr. Zeitler seconded that all other appeals under Agenda Item 9.A.ii. not specifically granted be denied. Motion carried.
