Applicants #542s application was reviewed due to a mental impairment and ADHD.

Dr. Arambula moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the requirements:

- Submit to an independent psychiatric evaluation by a forensic psychiatrist appointed by the Executive Director and follow any recommendations. If continued care is recommended, applicant will submit up to three names as treating psychiatrists for approval by Executive Director. Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board two times each year or as recommended by forensic psychiatrist.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist. Monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board two times each year.
- Submit to a physical examination related to perimenopausal symptoms by an approved physician within 30 days.
- o Submit reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- o Shall not withdraw from care or treatment.
- o Will notify Compliance Dept upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- Applicant must give copy of the Order to Program Director and request quarterly reports are sent to the Texas Medical Board.
- o May supervise PAs and APNs.
- o Probation appearance at any time on request with 10 days notice.
