1997 Board Rules Changes

All rule changes that were effective 12-23-97 are summarized below.

Chapter 161.1, General Provisions amendments to outline responsibilities of the Telemedicine Committee.

Chapter 163.16 and 163.17, Licensure new sections regarding licensure by fifth pathway.

Chapter 166.2, Physician Registration amendment to clarify which CME courses involving the study of medical ethics and/or professional responsibility are recognized by the board to be in compliance with CME requirements.

Chapter 174.16, Telemedicine new section outlining requirements for annual registration of telemedicine license holders.

Chapter 175.1, Schedule of Fees & Penalties amendment which increases the annual registration fee to \$310.

Chapter 179.4, Investigation Files amendment clarifying reporting requirements.

Chapter 185.2,.4,.19,.20-23 and .25, Physician Assistants amendments relating to the definition of physician assistant, documentation requirements for licensure and renewal, grounds for denial of licensure and for disciplinary action, reporting requirements, prehearing procedures and administrative penalties for physician assistants.

Chapter 193.1-193.7, Standing Delegation Orders reorganization of the entire chapter, incorporates several legislative changes, deletes old section 7 regarding rad techs and renumbers the sections.

Chapter 194.1-194.11, Non-Certified Radiologic Technicians new sections outlining requirements for registration and disciplinary action for those persons who perform radiologic procedures under the supervision of licensed physicians.
