**Executive Director Proposed Non-Public/Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order**

The Executive Director recommends that the applicant be granted a Texas Medical License under the terms and conditions listed below. The applicant has agreed to and signed this proposed order.

<b>TERMS AND CONDITIONS</b>	<b>860</b>
<b>LENGTH OF ORDER:</b>	5 years
<b>DRUG/ALCOHOL:</b>	
1. <b>[ABSTAIN &amp; DRUG SCREENS]</b> Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test [e01]	Required
5. <b>[AA / NA] AA OR NA</b> meeting at least <b>3</b> times each week <b>OR</b> month. [e16 or e17]	
<b>PSYCHIATRIC:</b>	
7. <b>[INDEPENDENT PSYCHIATRIC EVALUATION]</b> Submit to IPE by psychiatrist appointed by ED and follow recommendations. If continued care recommended, Respondent submit up to 3 names as treating psychiatrist for approval of ED. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist 4 times each year. [e04]	
9. <b>[MONITOR FOR TREATMENT Required with either 7 or 8]</b> Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or ED appoints a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to Board 2 times each year. [e06]	
<b>MISC. PROVISIONS:</b>	
11. Standard Requirements:	
<b>[REPORTS]</b> Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request [e11]	
<b>[NO UNILATERAL WITHDRAWAL]</b> Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment [e12]	
<b>PRESCRIBING AUTHORITY</b>	
16. <b>[SELF-PRESCRIBE/FAMILY]</b> Shall not treat self or immediate family [f09]	
23. <b>[ABILITY TO SUPERVISE]</b> May May NOT supervise PAs [o02]	
<b>PROBATION APPEARANCES</b>	
27. <b>[ON REQUEST &amp; NOTICE]</b> Anytime on request & 10 days notice [l02]	
<b>Temporary License?</b>	<b>No</b>
