TMB suspends Beaumont physician

On May 16, 2024, a disciplinary panel of the Texas Medical Board temporarily suspended, without notice, the Texas medical license of Salem A. Salem, M.D. (Lic. No. Q2704) after determining his continuation in the practice of medicine poses a continuing threat to public welfare. The suspension was effective immediately.

The Board panel found that Dr. Salem is suffering from an impairment that interferes with his ability to safely practice. Dr. Salem was issued a protective order, finding Dr. Salem committed family violence and that the order was necessary to prevent future family violence. Additionally, Dr. Salem submitted false information to the Board on a renewal application.

A temporary suspension hearing with notice will be held as soon as practicable with 10 days' notice to Dr. Salem, unless the hearing is specifically waived by Dr. Salem.

The temporary suspension remains in place until the Board takes further action.
