Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
April 12, 2007

Applicant #545s application was reviewed due to treatment for Obsessive Compulsive Disorder, Anxiety and Depression.

Mr. Miles moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to 3 names for treating psychiatrist for approval by the Executive Director. Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist. Monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board two times each year.
- Submit reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care or treatment.
- Will notify Compliance Dept upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at any time on request with 10 days notice.
