Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
June 26, 2008

Applicant #651s application was reviewed due to Opioid Addiction (Fentanyl) and for currently being monitored by the Texas Medical Board under a board order. The order is effective for the duration of the PIT permit. Applicant #651 is scheduled to complete training in August 2008 and is now applying for a full license.

Dr. Kalafut moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for 8 ½ years restricting the applicant from practicing anesthesiology and that includes the following requirements:
