Licensure Committee Proposed Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
December 7, 2006

Applicant #513s application was reviewed due to alcohol abuse.

Ms. Raggette moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training Permit under a public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- AA meetings three times each week.
- Participate in medical society health and rehabilitation program one time a week.
- Submit to IPE within 30 days of starting second year of residency training program and follow recommendations.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- Probation appearance anytime on request and 10 days notice.

In addition, Ms. Raggette moved to recommend to the full Board that the Applicant be assessed an administrative penalty in the amount of \$500.
