Medical Board Suspends License of Khanh Nguyen Vu, D.O., of Titusville, Pennsylvania

A panel of the Texas Medical Board suspended the license of Khanh Nguyen Vu, D.O., Texas license number L0676, after determining that Dr. Vu's continuation in the practice of medicine presents a continuing threat to the public welfare.

The temporary suspension hearing took place Friday, May 23, under the Board's authority, granted by S.B. 104 of the 78th Legislature, to suspend or restrict a physician's license without notice when it determines the physician's continuation in practice would constitute a continuing threat to the public welfare. The suspension took effect on May 28.

The action was based on the following findings: On September 5, 2007, Dr. Vu pleaded no contest to three counts of indecent assault in the Court of Common Pleas of Crawford County, Pennsylvania, Criminal Division. The three counts involved improper sexual contact with 14 different female patients. A TMB panel determined that Dr. Vu's actions establish a clear pattern of conduct that is a continuing threat to public health and safety.

The length of a temporary suspension is indefinite and remains in effect until the board takes further action.
