Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
December 7, 2006

Applicant #486s application was reviewed due to multiple arrests and citations that are primarily alcohol related.

Dr. Price moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training Permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the PIT that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test
- 3 AA meetings and 1 Caduceus meeting weekly.
- Within six months of signing the order submit to IPE arranged by the board and follow recommendations.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs
- Probation appearance once during the first year and then upon request.
- Must appear before the Licensure Committee for consideration of a full license.
