MINUTES OF THE
DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE
August 27, 2015

Chair Julie K. Attebury, called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. Other members present were, Allan Shulkin, M.D., Karl W. Swann, M.D., Surendra K. Varma, M.D., Stanley Wang, M.D., and George Willeford III, M.D. Committee Members Michael Arambula, M.D., Pharm.D, Margaret C. McNeese, M.D., David Baucom, James "Scott" Holliday, D.O., and Manuel Guajardo, M.D., were not present.

Staff members present were Mari Robinson, Executive Director, Robert Bredt, M.D., Medical Director, and various other staff.

Agenda Item #2. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals and reports from the Texas Physician Health Program (PHP).

The Executive Director, Dr. John B. Fitzwater, presented the status of certain cases in PHP's current caseload to the DPRC for possible referral back to the Board and requested guidance.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that PHP Case #1 remain under the management of PHP. Motion carried.

Case #2 for committee review was withdrawn by PHP.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that PHP Case #3 remain under the management of PHP. Motion carried.

Dr. Wang moved, and Willeford seconded that PHP Case #4 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that PHP Case #5 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Willeford moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that for PHP Case 15-0233 the committee accept the interim referrals made returning the case to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board for action prior to this meeting. Motion carried.

The committee directed staff to increase level to same line of Texas Medical Board participants.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that Licensee #1 and Licensee #2 be informed that their options are either to agree to change their license status to retired, emeritus retirement, administrative, oversight with PHP, or to enter the investigation process, and if there is proof of impairment, proceed to ISC.
