

**Action Item Agenda Item 2a Applicant #241**  
**Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order**  
**August 23, 2007**

Applicant #241's application was reviewed mental conditions that may affect the practice of medicine, namely, Major Depressive Disorder and Attention Deficit Disorder.

Mr. Webb recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for five years that includes the following requirements:

- Continue treatment with current treating psychiatrist. Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Frequency of visits to be dictated by the treating psychiatrist.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment
- Restriction to approved group/institutional setting, in which the other physicians in the group are involved with one another's practices
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearances anytime on request and 10 days notice.
