Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order  
April 12, 2007

Applicant #546s application was reviewed due to the applicants history of substance and alcohol abuse, action taken by another board, action taken by a health care facility, malpractice and poor evaluation.

Dr. Price moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas Medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with Texas Medical Board screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- Attend AA meeting at least five times each week.
- Participate in medical society and rehabilitation program.
- Submit up to 3 names for treating psychiatrist for approval by the Executive Director.  
Treating psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist. Monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Texas Medical Board two times each year.
- Submit reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care or treatment.
- Will notify Compliance Dept upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- Restrict practice to an approved group or institutional setting.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at any time on request with 10 days notice.
- Pass the Special Purpose Examination (SPEX) within three attempts within one year.
