TMB restricts Garland physician

On October 2, 2014, a disciplinary panel of the Texas Medical Board temporarily restricted, with notice, the Texas medical license of Robert Eugene Flynn, M.D., under the authority of Section 164.0595 of the Medical Practice Act. The restriction was effective immediately.

The restriction prohibits Dr. Flynn from having any contact with children in the course and scope of his practice as a physician.

The temporary restriction was based on the panel's findings that on March 6, 2014, Dr. Flynn was arrested on charges that included an alleged violation of Texas Penal Code, 21.02, which the Board learned of at the time Dr. Flynn completed his license renewal in August 2014. The matter is currently set for a jury trial in Collin County in December 2014.

The temporary restriction remains in place until the Board takes further action.
