

TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD
LICENSURE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
June 26, 2014

The meeting was called to order 10:42 a.m. on June 26, 2014 by Chair, Michael Arambula, M.D., Committee members present were Frank S. Denton; John D. Ellis, Jr.; Carlos Gallardo; Robert B. Simonson, D.O.; and Timothy Webb.

Mr. Ellis moved, Mr. Gallardo seconded, that the Committee close the meeting to the public and continue in Executive Session for deliberations concerning Agenda item 2a. The motion passed. Dr. Arambula announced that the meeting would be closed for deliberations at 10:44 a.m. concerning licensure applications and the character and fitness of applicants under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009 and 155.058, Occupations Code, and that while in executive session, the Board would not take any action, make any decision, or vote with regard to any matter that may be considered or discussed. A certified agenda of any executive session will be made.

Wynne M. Snoots, M.D. entered the meeting at 10:44 a.m.

Paulette B. Southard entered the meeting at 10:50 a.m.

The Executive Session ended at 2:50 p.m.

The Licensure Committee conducted hearings to review applicants appearing concerning eligibility. The hearings were conducted in Executive Session. Following the hearings, the Committee reconvened and considered the applications.

Agenda Item 2a - Applicants appearing concerning eligibility

Applicant #1092 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Gallardo moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for reinstatement of their license.** This recommendation is based on the applicant's unprofessional conduct and failure to demonstrate reinstatement was in the best interest of the public. **Ms. Southard seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1181 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Webb** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. **Mr. Ellis** seconded the motion. **Mr. Denton, Mr. Ellis, Dr. Simonson, Dr. Snoots, and Mr. Webb** voted for the motion. **Mr. Gallardo and Ms. Southard** voted against the motion. The motion passed.

Applicant #1520 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Webb** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant's application for a full license be deferred to allow Board staff time to verify the applicant's military credentials. If credentials meet criteria, applicant should be licensed. If credentials do not meet criteria, applicant will be required to appear before committee. **Dr. Snoots** seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed. The committee directed Board staff to draft a rule for stakeholder review to address adding domestic training that has been approved by a specialty board of the American Board of Medical Specialties(ABMS) or Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists(BOS) to the definition of a two year training program. The goal would be to address eligibility for applicants whose domestic training was accepted by the ABMS or BOS even though it may not have been accredited at the time of training.

Applicant #1533 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Dr. Snoots** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a physician in training permit, under a non-disciplinary Remedial Plan with the following conditions:

- 8 hours of CME in ethics

This recommendation is based on unprofessional conduct and submitting a false statement to the Board. **Ms. Southard** seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1536 appeared before the Committee, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Ellis** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. **Dr. Snoots** seconded the motion. **Mr. Gallardo** voted against the motion. All others voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1541 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Gallardo** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for a license. This recommendation is based on unprofessional conduct. **Ms. Southard** seconded the motion. **Dr. Snoots** voted against the motion. All others voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1542 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Denton** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a license subject to a non-disciplinary Remedial Plan with the following conditions:

- **8 hours of CME in ethics**
- **Participate in the University of Texas Dallas Physician Coaching Program**

This recommendation is based on unprofessional conduct. **Mr. Gallardo** seconded the motion. **Ms. Southard** voted against the motion. All others voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1543 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Denton** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. **Mr. Gallardo** seconded the motion. **Ms. Southard** voted against the motion. All others voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #1545 appeared before the Committee in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Gallardo** moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for a license due to unprofessional conduct, being disciplined by another state, disciplinary action taken by a health care entity, and submitting a false statement to the Board. **Ms. Southard** seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Item 2b - Proposed orders offered by the Executive Director –**Ms. Knight** reported on ten physician licensure orders offered by the Executive Director and accepted by applicants. **Mr. Gallardo** moved to recommend to the full Board that the orders be approved. **Ms. Southard** seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Item 2c – Physician licensure applicants to be licensed. There were 126 applicants who met all requirements to be considered for permanent licensure by the full Board. **Mr. Webb** moved to recommend to the full Board that all 126 physician licensure applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. **Ms. Southard** seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Item 2d – Surgical assistant licensure applicants to be licensed. There were 8 surgical assistant applicants who met all requirements to be considered for licensure by the full Board. **Ms. Southard** moved to recommend to the full Board that all 8 surgical assistant applicants determined to meet

eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 2e – Acudetox applicants for certification – There were none

Agenda Item 3 – Report on physician licensure statistics. Ms. Knight reported that the average time to complete applications for physician licensure in the third quarter of FY 14 was 34 days. Ms. Knight also reported on the record number of physician licensure applications the Board has received for eight of the nine recorded months of FY 14 so far, as well as the increase in the number of licenses issued.

Agenda Item 4a - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Nonprofit Health Organizations: Applicants for initial certification. There were eleven applications for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Mr. Webb moved to recommend to the full Board that the eleven requests for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4b - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Nonprofit Health Organizations: Requests for biennial recertification - There were 19 applications for biennial recertification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. **Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full Board that the 19 requests for biennial recertification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Mr. Gallardo seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4c - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Nonprofit Health Organizations: Cancellations of organizations certified as Nonprofit Health Organizations - There were none

Agenda Item 5 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding substantial equivalence list – Ms. Knight discussed the presentation given by Ross University School of Medicine (RUSM) at the May 2014 board meeting and whether the committee wanted to make any changes to the notation following RUSM on the substantial equivalence list, which advises applicants that portions of the RUSM status on the list curriculum are under review due to concerns regarding clinical rotations not meeting eligibility requirements. The Committee directed staff to keep the note, to provide statistics of RUSM graduates who have been determined ineligible due to unaccredited clerkships on an annual basis, and to send RUSM a formal letter regarding this decision. Ms. Knight also reported that the American

Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO) considers the three Caribbean schools currently on the substantial equivalence list (Ross University School of Medicine, St. George's University, and the American University of the Caribbean) to offer degrees or credits that are comparable to degrees or credits awarded by an institution in the United States that is not accredited.

Agenda Item 6 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding applicant packets –

Mr. Freshour proposed the reordering of the applicant packet to exclude items that have no bearing on the issues for which the applicant is appearing. Mr. Freshour further explained that this would allow the packets to be released to the applicant and give the applicant the opportunity to review the same supporting documentation available to the committee. The committee directed staff to use the proposed format for future committee packets with implementation in August or November.

Agenda Item 7 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Ten Year Rule – Ms.

Knight discussed the current rule which requires current certification as well as passage of a specialty board recertification exam as one remedy, but also allows passage of the Special Purpose Examination (SPEX) to meet the ten year rule, and the disparity between those two remedies since an applicant who allowed specialty board certification to lapse might pass a monitored written exam to obtain recertification, but would potentially not complete the process until other requirements have been fulfilled. The committee directed staff to draft a rule change to allow passage of a written, monitored specialty board exam to satisfy the ten year rule without holding current board certification.

Agenda Item 8 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding electronic verification of Texas medical schools and training programs –

Ms. Knight described a system at another state board that allows medical schools and training programs to electronically verify medical education and post graduate training for a licensure application. The committee directed staff to research what resources would be needed to put a similar system in place.

Agenda Item 9 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding authorizing staff to allow applicants to withdraw and reapply following the discovery of discrepancies –

Mr. Freshour explained that failure to provide accurate information on an application by failing to respond to a question correctly is considered falsification of a government document and a violation of the law. Allowing staff to give an applicant the opportunity to change an answer would result in accountability issues and inconsistent determinations. Mr. Freshour discussed the new application questions that will be deployed at the end of August and explained how this should help eliminate many instances of falsification issues.

Mr. Freshour also discussed how the outreach program has also helped reduce the number of instances of falsification on applications. The committee directed staff to continue with the processes in place.

Agenda Item 10 - Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding proposed amendments to board rules:

- b. 163.6(f) – Examinations Accepted for Licensure

Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full Board that the rule as presented be published in the Texas Register for public comment. Mr. Gallardo seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

- a. 187.5 NPDB reporting

Mr. Webb moved to recommend to the full Board that the rule as presented under option one be published in the Texas Register for public comment and to include a link to the NPDB on TMB's website. Mr. Gallardo seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 13 - There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:58 p.m.

§163.6. Examinations Accepted for Licensure.

(a) – (e) – unchanged

(f) The time frame ~~to pass each part of the examination~~ described by subsections ~~(b),~~ (c) and (d) of this section does not apply to an applicant who meets the following criteria:

- (1) holds a license to practice medicine in another state;
- (2) is in good standing in such state;
- (3) has been licensed in such state for at least five years;
- (4) such license has not been restricted, cancelled, suspended, revoked, or subject to other discipline in that state;
- (5) will practice exclusively in a medically underserved area or a health manpower shortage area, as those terms are defined in Chapter 157 of the Texas Occupations Code; and
- (6) has never held a medical license that has been restricted for cause, canceled for cause, suspended for cause, revoked or subject to another form of discipline in a state or territory of the United States, a province of Canada, or a uniformed service of the United States.
