Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order  
October 5, 2006

Applicant #499s application was reviewed due to alcohol dependence.

Dr. Guajardo moved to recommend to the full board that applicant be the applicant be granted a Physician in Training Permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the PIT that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TSBME screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- 4 AA meetings each week and include Caduceus meetings.
- Continue treatment with current treating physician (Addictionologist) once a month for the first year and then as recommended thereafter. Addictionologist is to watch for depressive symptoms
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition twice a year.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once 1<sup>st</sup> year and on then request.
