2002 Board Rules Changes

The following is a summary of the changes that were effective May 9, 2002 unless otherwise indicated.

Chapter 184, <u>Surgical Assistants</u>. New sections 184.1-184.16, regarding the regulation of surgical assistants as mandated by HB1183 of the 77th Legislature. Sections 184.2, .3, .5, .7, .9-.12, .14, and .16 effective April 28, 2002. Sections 184.1, .6, .8, .13, and .15 effective April 8, 2002 as emergency rules and effective June 18, 2002 as permanent rules. Section 184.4 effective May 29, 2002 as an emergency rule.

Chapter 185, <u>Physician Assistants</u>. Amendment to section 185.16 prohibiting a physician assistant from being supervised by a physician under a board order. Effective May 9, 2002.

Chapter 189, <u>Compliance Program.</u> New sections 189.1-189.14 relating to requirements and responsibilities for probationers and the system for monitoring a probationer's compliance. Effective May 9, 2002.

Chapter 193, <u>Standing Delegation Orders</u>. Amendment to section 193.6 regarding the delegation of prescriptive authority to alternate practice sites as specified in SB1166. Effective May 9, 2002.
