## TEXAS STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT EXAMINERS DISCIPLINARY AND ETHICS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES February 28, 2003

Mr. Webb moved, Dr. Benold seconded, and the motion passed to go into executive session at 10:55 a.m. for private consultation and advice of counsel concerning pending or contemplated litigation, deliberations concerning licensure applications, and/or possible disciplinary action under the authority of the Open Meetings Act. Open session resumed at 11:16 a.m. and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made.
