Upon review of the application, the Executive Director of the Board determined that the Applicant meets all requirements for licensure, except that the Applicant has not provided documentation that the Applicant has, on a full-time basis, actively diagnosed or treated persons or has been on the active teaching faculty of an acceptable approved medical school, within either of the last two years preceding receipt of the application, as required by Board Rule 163.11 (22 Tex. Admin. Code 163.11). The Executive Director, therefore, recommended that the Applicant be granted a Texas medical license limited to the practice of administrative medicine subject to the consideration and approval of the Board.

Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full Board that all eight orders be approved. Dr. Benavides seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.
