AD HOC COMMITTEE REGARDING BOARD RULE 164.4

AUGUST 25, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 3:25 p.m. by the Chair, Pat Crocker, D.O. Committee members present were Michael Arambula, M.D.; Melinda McMichael, M.D.; Paulette Southard; Timothy Turner; and Irvin E. Zeitler, Jr., D.O. Snoots, M.D.; and George Willeford III, M.D. Staff members present were Mari Robinson, J.D., Executive Director; Nancy Leshikar, General Counsel; and various staff.

Agenda item #2, Approval of June 3, 2010 minutes. Ms. Southard moved, Dr. McMichael seconded, and the motion passed to approve the June 3, 2010 Ad Hoc Committee Regarding Rule 164.4 minutes.

Agenda item #3, Discussion, recommendation, and possible action relating to amendments to 22 T.A.C., 164.4. Advertising Board Certification. Written comments were received and reviewed. After discussion, the committee recessed at 3:53 p.m. for staff to draft additional changes to present back to the committee.

The meeting reconvened at 4:24 p.m.

After discussion, **Ms. Southard moved and Dr. McMichael seconded a motion to approve the amendments to 22 T.A.C., 164.4. Advertising Board Certification, as presented by staff. After discussion, Mr. Turner made a friendly amendment, Ms. Southard seconded, and the motion passed to amend subsection (i) so that it reads as follows:**

(i) A physician who holds a certification that was granted prior to September 1, 2010, **and whose certifying board** was approved by the medical board for advertising purposes as of September 1, 2010, is considered to meet the requirements of subsection (b).

A vote was taken on the original motion to approve the amendments to 22 T.A.C., 164.4. Advertising Board Certification, as drafted by staff including the friendly amendment to add the words and whose certifying board to subsection (i), and the motion passed to approve the amendment and to publish in the Texas Register for public comment.

There being no further agenda items, the meeting was adjourned at 4:35 p.m.
