- 2) Did the respondent's care of not check sodium or K levels for changes/increases in HCTZ medication therapy in a patient who presented with underlying hyponatremia meet the standard of care?**
- 3) in general, is it standard of care to never check electrolytes like Na and K with nature tics even without any underlying disease processes? Did the respondent meet the standard of care?**
