

TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD
MINUTES OF THE
DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE
December 3, 2015

Chair Margaret C. McNeese, M.D., called the meeting to order at 8:10 am. Other members present were Julie K. Attebury, James “Scott” Holliday, D.O., Allan Shulkin, M.D., Karl W. Swann, M.D., Surendra K. Varma, M.D., Stanley Wang, M.D., and George Willeford III, M.D. Committee Members Michael Arambula, M.D., Pharm.D, David Baucom, and Manuel Guajardo, M.D., were not present.

Staff members present were Mari Robinson, Executive Director, Robert Bredt, M.D., Medical Director, and various other staff.

Agenda Item #2. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals and reports from the Texas Physician Health Program (PHP).

The Executive Director, Dr. John B. Fitzwater, presented the status of certain cases in PHP’s current caseload to the DPRC for possible referral back to the Board and requested guidance.

Dr. Willeford moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that PHP Case #1 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board pending the physician filing an application for a Physician in Training Permit (PIT) with the Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that PHP Case #2 remain under the management of PHP with the understanding that there will be zero tolerance for any future violations. If any further violations occur the case will be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board for further action. Motion carried.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that PHP Case #3 remain under the management of PHP with the understanding that there is zero tolerance for any future infractions. If any further violations occur the case will be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board for further action. Motion carried.

The committee directed staff to evaluate the drug testing in relation to Soberlink.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Wang seconded that PHP Case #4 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Dr. Wang moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that PHP Case #5 be returned to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that PHP Case #6 remain under the management of PHP. Motion carried.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that PHP Case #7 remain under the management of PHP. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #3. Reports and discussion regarding Texas Physician Health Program. (Dr. Fitzwater)

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that the committee accepts the interim referral and the three emergent referrals made returning the cases to the jurisdiction of the Texas Medical Board. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #4. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding renewals involving impaired licensees. (Ms. Robinson)

Dr. Willeford moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that Licensee #1 be sent a letter informing him that the options are to refer his case back to the investigations department, convert his license to an administrative license, enter the PHP program, or retire. Motion carried.

The committee directed staff to look into an inactive license status options that Massachusetts and Michigan offer through their medical board.

Dr. Holliday moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that Licensee #2 be sent a letter informing him that the options are to refer his case to the investigations department, enter the PHP program, or retire. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #5. Reports and discussion regarding the Investigation, Litigation, and Compliance Departments.

Ms. Robinson presented the Enforcement Report for August 2015, a copy of which is attached. This was an informational item only and no vote was necessary.

Agenda Item #6. Discussion and possible direction regarding drug testing site waivers. (Dr. Bredt)

Dr. Holliday moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded, that the recommended changes presented by the Medical Director be accepted. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #7. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding Rule Review and proposed changes to the following chapters in Title 22 of the Texas Administrative Code:

- A. Chapter 170, Pain Management,
 - §170 Pain Management
- B. Chapter 190, Disciplinary Guidelines,
 - §190.8 (Subchapter B) Violation Guidelines

Dr. Varma moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that the amendments to rules §170 under Agenda Item 7.A. be approved for publication. Motion passes.

It was announced by Ms. Robinson that Agenda Item 7.B. §190.8 be stricken from the agenda.

Agenda Item #8. Review, discussion, and possible action regarding review of probationer's appearances.

Dr. Varma moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that the waiver list on Agenda Item #8 be approved. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #9. Consideration and approval of membership of the Expert Physician Panel.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that the appointments of members to the Expert Physician Panel be accepted as noted in the attachment. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #10. Reports and discussion regarding cases over one year old.

Ms. Robinson presented to the DPRC the current status of cases that are over one year old. To date, all investigations over one year are in criminal courts for a resolution and the majority of the litigation cases are at SOAH. This was an informational item only and no vote was necessary.

Agenda Item #12. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding routine follow-up on investigative files previously referred from the DPRC for follow-up action, specifically including: 15-1515, 15-4447.

Dr. Willeford moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded that follow-up file #15-1515 be dismissed and a custom letter sent. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that follow-up file #15-4447 be dismissed and a custom letter sent letting the Respondent know that this closed case would be brought forward along with any future complaints. Motion carried. Dr. Willeford recused himself from any discussion and decision on this case.

Dr. Willeford moved, and Ms. Attebury seconded; the motion passed at 10:20 am. to go into Executive Session for deliberations concerning disciplinary action, investigative information, peer review information, and rehabilitation orders under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009, 160.006 through .008, 164.007(c), Texas Occupations Code. Open session resumed at 2:08 p.m., and it was announced that no action was taken during executive session. A certified agenda of the executive session was made.

Dr. Shulkin moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that the appeal of Item 11.A.i., Log #15-2760 be granted and sent back to the experts specifically to evaluate the evolution of the airway obstruction to see if it was caused by the earlier procedure and to evaluate the timeliness of the response. Motion carried.

Dr. Swann moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that the appeal of Item 11.B, Log #s 15-5271, 15-5272, 15-5273, 15-6074, 15-6075, 15-6076, 15-6587 and Item 11.C Log #s 15-6081, 15-6082, and 15-6588 be denied. Motion carried.

Dr. McNeese moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that the appeal of Item 11.B, Log #s 15-7382, 15-7439, and 15-7440 be denied. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that all other appeals under Agenda Item 11.A.i. not specifically granted above be denied. Motion carried.

Dr. Swann moved, and Dr. Shulkin seconded that the appeal of Item 11.A.ii., #15-0206 (14-5810) be granted, specifically that the actual MRI scans, be reviewed by Dr. Swann who will then give appropriate direction to Board staff. Motion carried.

Dr. McNeese moved, and Dr. Shulkin seconded that the appeal of Item 11.A.ii., #15-0515 (15-0146) be granted and that an ISC be scheduled and that ISC to be heard by a Board member is a psychiatrist. Motion carried.

Dr. Wang moved, and Dr. Shulkin seconded that the appeal of Item 11.B., Log #15-2970 be granted, specifically staff to gather appropriate records and submit for expert review. Motion carried.

Dr. McNeese moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that the appeal of Item 11.B., Log #15-7198 be granted and the case be returned to a pending determination status for an additional 45 days to obtain an appropriate response from the physician. Motion carried.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that the appeal of Item 11.B., Log #15-7638 be granted and the case be returned to a pending determination status for an additional 45 days to obtain an appropriate response from the physician. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that all other appeals under Agenda Item 11.B. not specifically granted above be denied, with the exception of Log 16-0157 which has

been moved to the March 2016 board meeting as a courtesy to the complainant. Motion carried.

Dr. Varma moved, and Dr. Willeford seconded that all other appeals under Agenda Item 11.C. be denied. Motion carried.

Agenda Item #13. Review, discussion, and possible action regarding selected files and cases.

Ms. Attebury moved, and Dr. Varma seconded that the investigations and cases reviewed by the committee be resolved as noted and that they be listed along with each resolution as part of the minutes of this Committee. Motion carried.

Dr. Willeford moved, and Dr. Holliday seconded that the meeting adjourn.
