 Applicant shall continue to receive care and treatment from current treating psychiatrist, or treating psychiatrist approved by the ED, and follow all recommendations. See at least 1 time each month or as directed by the treating psychiatrist.

- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition as requested by Board staff.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Director of Enforcement or Compliance Officer within 48 hours upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs and surgical assistants
- Probation appearance upon request.
