Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
February 7, 2008

After considering the applicants application and compliance with a previous non-public non-disciplinary agreed rehabilitation order in effect during the applicants Physician in Training permit, the Executive Director recommends that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under the terms and conditions listed below. The applicant has agreed to and signed this proposed order. **Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full Board that the order be approved. Dr. Benavides seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.**

Order allows applicant to be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for five years that includes the following requirements:

- Applicant shall continue to receive care and treatment from current treating psychiatrist, or treating psychiatrist approved by the ED, and follow all recommendations. See at least 1 time each month or as directed by the treating psychiatrist.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition as requested by Board staff.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Director of Enforcement or Compliance Officer within 48 hours upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs and surgical assistants
- Probation appearance upon request.
