DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE
October 15, 2020 at 9:30 am

Chair, Manuel Quinones, Jr., M.D., called the meeting to order at 9:37 a.m. Other members present were Sharon Barnes, Devinder S. Bhatia, M.D., Robert Gracia, LuAnn Morgan, Jason K. Enforcement Report August 2020

Enforcement Highlights

Investigation Department

During August 2020, staff initiated 149 investigations. Of these investigations, 51.0% (76) involved initial allegations of quality of care concerns, 0% (0) involved medical malpractice concerns, and 6.0% (9) involved initial allegations of substance abuse or physical/mental impairment. Staff completed 301 investigations, referring 30.5% (92) to the Litigation Department for prosecution.

Litigation Department

During August 2020, staff held 77 I.S.C./Show Compliance Proceedings, 1 Mediation and 1 Temporary Suspension Hearing.

Compliance Department

As of August 2020, there are 687 probationers and staff conducted 268 drug/alcohol screens.

Board Actions

The Medical Board met in August and issued 32 disciplinary decisions, 31 non-disciplinary decisions and 60 legal dismissals.

The Physician Assistant Board did not meet in August.

The Board of Acupuncture Examiners did not meet in August.
