Action Item Agenda Item 2a2 Applicant #815 Licensure Committee Proposed <u>Public</u> Non-Disciplinary Order

Applicant #815 appeared with counsel, before the Committee in executive session, on referral by the Executive Director. In open session, Dr. Holliday moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted Physician in Training permit under a public, non-disciplinary order that includes the requirements specified in the Rehabilitation Checklist that has been distributed to the members of the committee. This recommendation is due to disciplinary action taken by a health care entity; unprofessional conduct that is likely to deceive, defraud or injure the public; placement on deferred adjudication for a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude; and excessive use of drugs or alcohol that renders applicant unable to safely practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety. Factors contributing to this recommendation include a lengthy history of drug dependency; termination from residency training program due to drug dependency issues and failure to stay in treatment for condition; and placement on deferred adjudication for misdemeanor assault that included probation for 12 months. In addition, Dr. Holliday moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Physician in

Training permit, subject to an adminis trative penalty in the amount of \$4000. This recommendation is due to submission of false statements on two applications for Physician in Training permits. Factors contributing to this recommendation include the committees determination that the falsification was intentional. Mitigating factors include sobriety since 2007, being offered a residency position with the program that had previously terminated applicant, and applicants compliance and successful completion of applicants two-year physician rehabilitation agreement with the Harris County Medical Society. Mr. Turner seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.
