MINUTES OF THE
DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE
AUGUST 17, 2023 9:30 am

Chair, Manuel Quinones, Jr., M.D., called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Other members present were Sharon Barnes, Devinder S. Bhatia, M.D., James S. Distefano, D.O., Robert Gracia, LuAnn Morgan, Jason K. Tibbles, M.D., and Sherif Zaafran, M.D. David G. Vanderweide, M.D. was not in attendance.

Staff members present were Stephen Brint Carlton, J.D., Executive Director; Robert Bredt, M.D., Medical Director; Chris Palazola, J.D., Director of Operations; and various other staff.

Agenda Item #2. Texas Physician Health Program (TXPHP).

A. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals.

Ms. Barnes moved and Ms. Morgan seconded that TXPHP Case No. 17-0329-A MD, 21-0410 DO, 22-1105 PIT MD, 22-1107 MD, remain under the management of TXPHP. Motion carried.

Ms. Morgan moved and Mr. Gracia seconded that TXPHP Case No. 17-0376-A MD, be returned to the jurisdiction of the TMB. Motion carried.

B. Report on Emergent Referrals.

There was a discussion regarding changes to the expert panelist process. **The committee directed staff to implement new expert panelist review process - for cases in which standard of care not found by first reviewer, only one review will be obtained. A second reviewer will not be utilized in such cases. For cases in which physician is practicing outside the area of specialty, the first reviewer obtained will be an expert in the area of practice at issue.**

Dr. Zaafran moved and Dr. Distefano seconded to reject approval of the recommendation to dismiss case 23-3237, send the case back to the expert panel to obtain an opinion on the appropriateness of the first visit. The motion carried.

Dr. Zaafran moved and Ms. Barnes seconded to deny approval of the recommended dismissal of case 23-4590, and send it back to obtain an expert panel opinion on whether the patient should have been admitted to the hospital. The motion carried.
